The competition is open to all ages but we do encourage newbie's to the competition scene and especially juniors (U/21) from all clubs and organisations, e.g. Scouts, Cadets, Schools, Rifle Clubs etc so it presents a great opportunity to see how shooters measure up.

The Autumn term is a relatively short time window to "get into the flow" after the summerbreak with juniors commencing new education years, changing schools, colleges, etc., - all welcome!

So.... your main competitor will be yourself..... to encourage working on performance improvement through practice and coaching ready for the '26 Camelot and other matches.

Every entry, that submits their 40 shots within time limit, will receive identical medals

Guidance / Rules ~

Please get your entry forms to us by Fri. 31 Oct. 2024.

Cards to be shot by Sun 30th Nov. and last posting date Mon.1st Dec.

Rifle shooters may enter any combination of the following rifle classes ~

- ▶ Six Yard Sporter Air Rifle ~ Pre-Charged (.177)
- ▶ Six Yard Sporter Air Rifle ~ Springer (.177)
- ▶ Ten Metre Sporter Air Rifle ~ Pre-Charged (.177)
- ▶ Ten Metre Sporter Air Rifle ~ Springer (.177)
- ▶ Ten Metre Precision Air Rifle ~ (.177)

and then within the class each shooter may enter for 1, 2 or 3 positions,

Kneeling, Prone and / or Standing, in any combination, and all within discipline rules!

Pistol Shooters may also enter any combination of the following classes ~

- ▶ Six Yard Air Pistol (.177)
- ▶ Ten Metre Air Pistol (.177)

Shooters will shoot 40 competition shots, per entry, as per dates above.

Only original NSRA or ISSF approved targets may be used.

For all Air Rifle targets, be it 6 yds or 10m, shooters will put 2 shots on each bull, i.e. 10 per card. For all Air Pistol targets, 5 shots on each target. Unusual for rifle but of particular use to those who are “manual changers”!

PRIOR to shooting targets must have **CLEARLY written** on the front of them, shooters name and club, the word “Precis.” / “SAR”(PC) / “SAR”(Spring) / Pistol to denote the class, plus, **position being used**, (single letter – K,P or S) and numbered 1,2 etc in the order in which the cards are to be shot.

This may be done by anyone and pre homemade stickers may be used, but...

they ***MUST BE LABELLED PRIOR TO SHOOTING AS ABOVE !!!***

On the rear THE RANGE OFFICER, PRIOR TO SHOOTING, MUST SIGN the card behind the centre of the centre bull AND PRINT their name or initials.

(REMINDER - ALL of the above MUST BE before the target is used)

ONCE SHOT the RO must sign the witness box, and add the date, on the front of the card to signify that they take responsibility for the card being a correctly shot valid entry.

Note - DO NOT score cards or gauge pellet holes, unless you have an NSRA Qualified Scorer who has attached a copy of their certificate to the entry form, or with sent it with cards.

NO OTHER PERSONS MAY SCORE – NSRA Scorer Qualified only

When packaging cards please be mindful of how unforgiving some of the automatic sorting machines can be, a ring of sellotape all the way round an envelope in the middle of both the horizontal and vertical can be a “card saver”. If no cards are received and you have proof of posting we will issue a reshoot instruction, but damaged envelopes / cards that were not securely packaged cannot receive the same treatment.

Those shooting SAR are required to shoot compliant to SAR competition rules, so pre competition is a good time to ensure rifles are indeed compliant, e.g. 500gms trigger weight – if in doubt on how to adjust read the manufacturers handbook! Also remember no barrel extensions or sights with any magnification (i.e. no telescopic sights), again if unsure ASK!

It is the RO's job to ensure compliance and their signature on used targets is their personal confirmation of this.
